

## CAMPN RV – Covid-19 Restrictions and Information – last updated Sept 7, 2020

The following information is at the direction of Alberta Health and it amended from time to time. You can find the most up to date information at [www.alberta.ca/covid19](http://www.alberta.ca/covid19). Alberta is currently in STAGE 2 for reopening.

**We must ensure the sacrifices we have already made are not wasted. To be successful, we must stay vigilant to slow the spread: follow public health measures, practice physical distancing and good hygiene, and continue acting responsibly.**

Failure to adhere to policies and Alberta Public Health Orders may be putting people at risk. As a result you may asked to leave without refund being issued. Questions regarding campground use can be made by calling Ken at 780-875-4663.

**Please advise us prior to your arrival, or if conditions change during your stay if you are Covid-19 positive, currently under quarantine/isolation or have symptoms such as cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat.**

### **Campground information –**

- Camping units with self-contained washroom/shower facilities are encouraged to use their own facilities. Tents are accepted. Washroom and shower is available.
- Washroom and laundry can be accessed in the common room building. Continue to wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before and after using our facilities. Please limit number of persons within this building to one person or one family from the same household. Our buildings are off limits to persons who are required to self-isolate. Our washrooms and showers in our facilities are ONLY intended for those without self-contained working units such as tent, tent trailers or campers with short term a breakdown in their unit.
- We will attempt to accommodate special needs, please contact us directly.
- Keep in mind that not all surfaces can be fully disinfected (i.e picnic tables, play grounds, garbage containers, books, water taps, sewer connections, etc) practice good hygiene, regularly wash your hands and avoid touching your face after touching surfaces on this property.
- Site registration and payment are being accepted remotely.
- Insure your site is left clean of debris (including cigarette butts) and disposed in designated garbage containers.
- The two centralized fire pits areas are open for use, Propane fire pits can be used at your site. If you would like a propane fire pit rental for your personal use contact Ken at the office.
- Maintain physical distancing, and use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol content immediately before and after using playground equipment.

### **Alberta Health recommendations-**

- Use of masks are encouraged where indoors with others or where you cannot maintain a minimum of 2 meters from each other.
- Non-essential travel, especially outside the province, continues to be not recommended.
- For activities such as barbecues, picnics or drinks with friends and neighbors refer to Alberta Health website for current limitations. Consider using open areas away from your campsite/residence for socializing with others outside you cohort.

### **Alberta Health Continuing restrictions –**

- **Physical distancing restrictions of at least 2 meters shall be maintained at all times.** There is no evidence that dogs carry or transmit COVID-19, but transmission should be prevented between park users.
- **Travelers under quarantine/self-isolation are restricted to their site.**
- Group camping or functions.
- Visitors and guests must check in at the office prior to being permitted access to the property.
- One Washroom and Showers will be available for use for those not under quarantine/isolation.
- Public washrooms for visitors are not provided at this time.
- Access to our buildings continues to be off limits to persons who are required to self-isolate.
